

WENDAT NAMES AT LORETTE 1762 - 1791

Abstract

Wendat names recorded at Lorette between 1762 and 1791 are presented and examined.

Introduction

The names for this research bulletin are taken from an anonymously written source, "Liste des 8adats qui ont été baptisés, mariés et inhumés au Village de Lorette pour les années 1762 jusqu'a 1889 incluses". While the list of names extends, as stated, from 1762 to 1889, the names that are Wendat, rather than French, extend only from 1762 to 1791, after which time the names were just recorded in French. What may be recorded here is the final shift to European-style names from traditional ones, a process that the Wyandot were similarly going through. In some places you can see that the Wendat names have become European-style 'last names' or family names. Native names would persist, but, officially, they would have lesser status than their European counterparts. At the same time, the language was dying. Mistakes made in the writing of the words present evidence for that.

The entries have been set up so that the way the name appears is first presented in bold, with optional aspects surrounded by brackets. We see from this that the -n- following a vowel, typically employed by the Jesuits to indicate that the vowel was nasal, was starting to disappear. To be noted as well is the fact that the -,- traditionally used by the Jesuits to indicate a -y- like sound has almost completely disappeared, used rarely after the first syllable, in one case replaced by the -l- that would indicate this sound in nineteenth century writing of Wendat at Lorette. Related to this is the fact that the -,- does not appear at the beginning of a word. This might not be because of the dying nature of the language. One other potential interpretation of this feature is that it represents an aspect of the Cord dialect of Wendat, the Cord being the core group making up the Huron of Lorette. The reason that this is suggested as an interpretation is that this dropping of the initial -y- sound was a feature of the closely related Southern Bear dialect (see Steckley 1997).

Immediately to the right of the initial part of each entry is my estimation of what

the spelling should have been, using the traditional orthography of the Jesuits. In the next line, underlined, is a suggested translation for the word. This is followed by the entries that appear in the list. After that is included whether or not the name appears also with the Wyandot of the eighteenth century (as recorded by Jesuit Father Pierre Potier, and appearing in Toupin 1996), and with the Wendat names recorded in the Jesuit Relations (see the appropriate Petun Research Institute Bulletin). We find in this regard that of the 74 names recorded in the list, there are 24 Jesuit Relations names and 33 Wyandot names. The latter points to a significant sharing of culture of the two Wendat peoples, in part the product of the minority Huron joining with the majority Petun in forming the Wyandot, in probable greater part a presumed pre-dispersal sharing of culture. The next line involves stating whether the name applies to a female, done because they are in a distinct minority, 14 out of 75.

It should be noted that the first or Christian names are sometimes written in French, sometimes in Latin.
